Purchases must be made at the Apple Online Store or an Apple Retail Store, or through Apple Telesales within Australia. Qualifying orders from the Apple Online Store or Apple Telesales that are placed during the promotion and ship after the offer ends are eligible, but claims must be submitted within ninety (90) days of your purchase. (postmarked on or before April 15, 2012)
